Islandhopping in the footsteps of Marco Polo

This Boat & Bike tour through Southern Dalmatia will take us past unique little towns and through beautiful island landscapes. Experience the islands of Brač, Korčula und Šolta as well as the beautiful lavender island of Hvar. Stroll around Hvar town with its mighty fortress and enjoy the relaxed atmosphere in the artist's town of Stari Grad. The UNESCO World Heritage cities of Trogir and Split will add to the highlights on this tour and inspire with their incredible history. Try a variety of local specialties on your journey, especially the local wines also referred to locally as 'gods drop'.

TO NOTE: This tour sometimes takes place parallel to our MTB tour on the same boat. One tour guide leads the cycling group, the other the mountain bikers. This is perfect for travellers who wish to spend their holiday together, but do not share the same riding preference.

Itinerary 2026

1st Day Trogir (Embarkation) – Island Solta

Individual arrival by car to Trogir or by plane to Split Airport, located about 3.5 mi./6 km away from the harbour of Trogir. After checking in on the motor yacht between 1 and 1:30 pm, the first cruise from Trogir to the island of Šolta begins at 2 pm. The first night is spent in a quiet harbour on the island of Solta with the opportunity to take a swim after a day of travel.

2nd Day Island Vis (aprx. 20 mi./31 km)

This morning we enjoy a cruise during breakfast to the Island of Vis. Vis is the furthestmost inhabited island from mainland Croatia. A Greek colony called Issa inhabited the island 2,300 years ago. Due to its strategic location it was a military zone until 1995 and prohibited for foreign tourists. Today we have the opportunity to explore the lovely island by bicycle. We have plenty of time to enjoy the island and spend the night here.

3rd Day Island Korčula(aprx. 18.5 mi./30 km)

In the morning we leave the island of Vis by boat and navigate to the harbor town of Vela Luka on the Island of Korčula. Along the way we throw the anchor for a refreshing swim stop. Korčula is regarded as one of the most scenic islands in the Adriatic, abundant in scenic impressions and quaint villages nestled in the green. Once we arrive in Vela Luka we can enjoy a round tour from Vela Luka to the village of Blato and back again. The night is spent in Vela Luka.

4th Day Hvar Town – Stari Grad – Jelsa – Stari Grad (aprx. 14 mi./22 km + aprx. 12 mi./20 km)

The day starts with a relaxing cruise to Hvar town on Hvar Island. Make use of the time before the cycle tour starts and go for a little stroll through the city. Standing on the magnificent Renaissance Square you can enjoy a view up to the Spanish fortress towering high above the city. Today's bike tour takes us from the city of Hvar through small villages and lavender fields to Stari Grad on the opposite side of the island. The descent to Stari Grad offers breathtaking views. After a lunch break we continue start off on a second cycling tour through the green planes of the island to the seaside town of Jelsa. After a break for coffee and ice cream, we continue the round trip back to Stari Grad where we spend the night.

5th Day Brač Island: Milna – Postira (aprx. 18 mi./29 km)

In the morning we cruise to the island of Brač, famous for its radiant, precious limestone that was, among others, used for the White House in Washington and in the construction of the German Reichstag building in Berlin. Once we have arrived on Brač, we start our bike tour from Milna to the picturesque harbor town of Postira. At first we cycle inland through small villages and past local architectural relics before hugging the coast with spectacular views across the channel to the mainland. On arrival in Postira there are many ways in which to enjoy the rest of the afternoon. The night is spent in the quiet harbor of Postira.

6th Day Omiš roundtour (aprx. 27 mi./44 km) or Rafting

During breakfast the boat brings us to Omiš. Today we have the choice either to take a bus transfer to go rafting through the Cetina Canyon (not included in the tour price) or to make a bike tour around Omiš. The rafting group will be picked up from the boat by a bus. From the starting point they will follow the river downstream in the rafts gaining a

unique perspective of the canyon and its flora and fauna. Participants of the rafting trip are brought back to the boat in the bus after the activity. In the afternoon we cruise to Split, where we spend the night.

7th Day Čiovo Island - Trogir (aprx. 12.5 mi./20 km)

In the morning, we enjoy our last cruise back to Trogir. From here, we take the bikes across the local bridge to Čiovo Island where we enjoy our last bicycle tour. Čiovo is a sea of flowers and the aromatic scent of wild herbs hangs in the air. We cycle to the local beach where we can enjoy a refreshing swim and coffee break before returning to the boat in Trogir. Once we arrive, there will be plenty of time to visit the Old Town of Trogir, listed as a UNESCO World Cultural Heritage Site. The last evening aboard is celebrated in traditional fashion in the company of our fellow travellers and guides.

8th Day Trogir (Disembarkation)

After breakfast disembarkation until 9 am followed by an individual trip home or extended stay in Dalmatia/Croatia.

San Snova

The wooden motor yacht San Snova took its maiden voyage in 2009 and was constructed exclusively for Islandhopping. Built by hand over the course of three years, this was the last wooden passenger ship of its kind to be built in Croatia. The cabins are spacious and comfortable and furnished functionally. They are all air conditioned and include a private bathroom with a shower and WC.

The wood clad saloon emits a relaxing atmosphere which is carried throughout the boat with the many comfortable sitting areas on the ships decks. Sunning mats can be enjoyed on the sundeck. The professional crew on board run a tight ship and everything is held sparkling clean. Come aboard and enjoy a truly unique atmosphere on board this beautiful piece of craftsmanship.

Parking

If you have booked a parking space, please come to the ship first to leave your luggage there. You will be given the exact location of the parking lot at check-in. As soon as you have parked your car/motorhome there, you will be transferred back to the port.

Arrival by airplane

For all tours starting in Trogir the closest airport is Split (SPU) that is situated at a distance of only 6 km/4 mi. from the town. If you are unable to find a suitable flight to

Split, you can alternatively fly to Dubrovnik or Zadar. We offer exclusive transfers from both airports. The transfer prices can be found under the section "From Zadar/Dubrovnik".
