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Turkey's hidden gems and natural paradise

The Gulf of Gökova, stretching between the historic city of Bodrum and the spectacular Datça-Peninsula, is a true scenic gem, and a highlight among our cycling tours in Turkey. Completely spared from mass tourism, it is here that Turkey shows its true colours, making it the ideal location for an unforgettable active holiday. Untamed nature with fantastic panoramas, small harbours, wonderfully clear water, and historical highlights are just a taste of what makes the Gökova Gulf so special, an area well worth exploring by bike and boat!

TO NOTE: This tour takes place parallel to our mountainbike tour on the same boat. This is perfect for travellers who wish to spend their holiday together, but do not share the same riding preference.



Itinerary

1st Day Bodrum (Embarkation)

Individual arrival to Bodrum harbour. A collective transfer from Bodrum Airport to the harbour is available for an extra cost on request. Check in begins on the Gullet at 2 pm. Use the evening hours to enjoy the lively atmosphere in the city of Bodrum and relax with a typical Turkish tea. In the evening, a shared dinner on board can be enjoyed in the company of your travel companions and tour guides.

2nd Day Bodrum - Yalıcıftlik (aprx. 23 mi./38 km)

Morning cruise to Yalıcıftlik. From here we start our first bike ride through the local pine forests to Camlik where we will have the chance to refresh ourselves with a short coffee break. We continue cycling through silver-green olive groves to the small village of Etrim. Ancestors of the Turkmen tribes continue to live semi-nomadic lives in the region. We can marvel at their fascinating hand crafts and during a lunch break at a local restaurant we can discover some local cuisine. After lunch we return to Yalıcıftlik where we can enjoy a swim in the afternoon at the nearby beach, followed by dinner on board. Overnight stay in Yalıcıftlik.

3rd Day Yalı Çiftlik - Mazı - Akbük (aprx. 26 mi./41 km)

From Yalı Çiftlik, our bike tour takes us inland through the scenic natural landscape before we head back to Mazı on the coast. Here, our ship awaits us for lunch on board. We relax for the two and a half hours crossing to Akbük, a charming little harbour where we can enjoy the afternoon swimming. Dinner on board and overnight in Akbük.

4th Day Akbük - Akyaka (aprx. 19.4 mi./31 km)

In the morning, a shuttle takes us from Akbük to the charming mountain village of Sarnıçköy. The bike tour leads us to the neighbouring village of Akyaka, where we can stop to admire the ancient rock tombs. This picturesque village is characterized by a pseudo-Seljuk-Ottoman architecture with significant wooden elements, unique to Turkey. This unique piece was designed by award-winning architect Nail Cakirhan. A short stroll through the village is well worthwhile. Dinner on board and overnight in Akyaka.

5th Day Akyaka - Çamlı (aprx. 21 mi./34 km)

In the morning, a bike tour takes you into unspoiled rural areas and the hinterland. Enjoy nature and experience unique cycling fun on village roads and forest paths. You then return to Akyaka for a lunch break. Afterwards, we head to the picturesque Çamlı bay, where we can take a refreshing swim. Dinner on board and overnight in Çamlı.

6th Day Çamlı - English Bay - Yedi adalar (aprx. 12.5 mi./20 km)

Today's bike tour takes us from Çamlı through small villages and fragrant pine forests to the picturesque English Bay. In this beautiful bay there will be plenty of time to swim to your heart's content. After the bike ride, we have one and a half hours to relax on board and enjoy the sun and the salty sea air while we cruise to Yedi Adalar (Seven Islands). Dinner on board and overnight on anchor.

7th Day Yedi Adalar - Körmen - Knidos (aprx. 26 mi./42 km)

The morning crossing takes us to Körmen on the Datça Peninsula, which we explore by bike. A first ascent leads us to a height of 450 m/1.480 ft, before we get to enjoy the descent back to the sea with a beautiful view over the Greek islands Nisyros, Tilos and Rhodes. The path leads us on a scenic road along the coast before entering the suburban outskirts of Knidos. Our ship will then sail back to the port of Bodrum, where you will enjoy a last meal on board.

8th Day Knidos - Bodrum (Disembarkation)

After breakfast on board, we get to enjoy the sea air one last time on the crossing back to Bodrum. Once in Bodrum, it is time to say goodbye to your ship, the crew, and tour guides. Check-out and (if any) transfer to the airport and individual travel back home or extension of your holiday in Turkey.

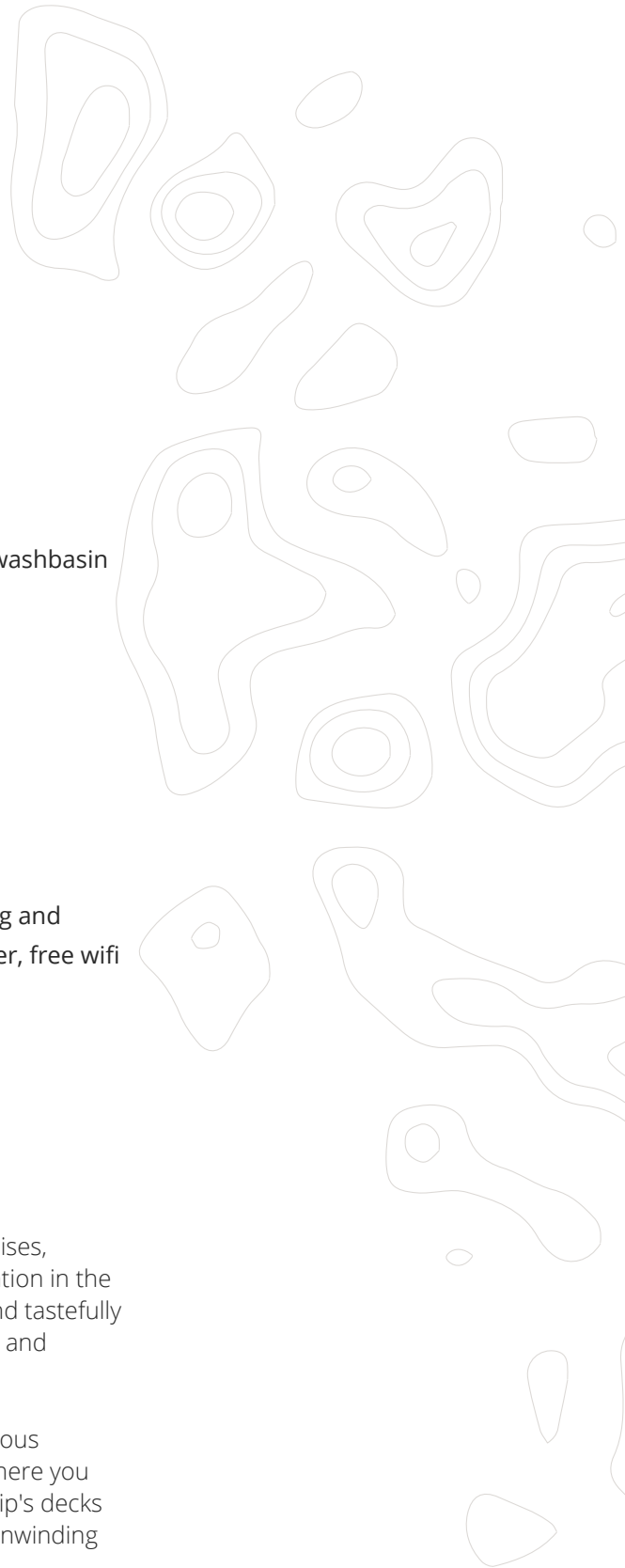

Arrival

Port of embarkation

This tour begins and ends in Bodrum or in Yalı Çiftlik, which belongs to the city district of Bodrum. It can be easily reached by airplane via Bodrum Airport (BJV). In order to avoid any travel complications whilst crossing the borders, we request that all guests obtain the appropriate travel documentation and visas before arrival on site.

Check in begins at 2 pm.

Berth Admiral

Embarkation on the [Admiral](#) takes place in Yalı Çiftlik, a small vilage just under 14 km away from Bodrum town. As the village only has one pier, you can't miss the ship. The small jetty is located directly at the [Belediyesi YALI Fish Restaurant](#) (on the right side of the beach as seen from the shore). As soon as you stand on the beach of Yali Ciftlik you will already see the boat.

Berth Boreas (Bodrum Harbour)

Should you wish to make your own way to the boat, you will find the [Boreas](#) in the big yacht harbour (when looking out to sea, on the right-hand side of the fortress of St. Peter). Most commonly it will be moored next to the Datca Ferry dock. The specific mooring of the ships will only be decided the evening before the trip.

Arrival by plane

A flight is the fastest, easiest, and most economical way to get to Turkey.

The closest airport is [Bodrum \(BJV\)](#). Most flights go to [Izmir airport \(ADB\)](#), which is situated about three hours from Bodrum. During the high season it is also possible to fly directly to Bodrum Airport.

When you book your flight, we ask you to choose a return flight with a departure time during noon or the afternoon hours so that we can facilitate a stress free

journey home for you.
