Greek island secrets by e-bike and boat

Spend a week exploring the southern Dodecanese islands by e-bike and a comfortable motor sailer, and experience their unique diversity. The trip takes you to the diverse island of Kos, the volcanic island of Nisyros with its steaming craters as well as to Symi with its beautiful island capital and to the mini-island of Tilos, which was once home to dwarf elephants.

A true highlight of the trip is the bike tour on the Datca Peninsula that leads through spectacular nature to the beautiful bay of Knidos. Come with us on a journey through time and discover the rock throwing Poseidon, the Knights of St John, and the famous sponge divers of Symi. They have all contributed to the unique character of these islands through their legacies.

This tour is part of our Islandhopping PLUS program. The PLUS tours offer our guests a PLUS all-round: a comfortable motor yacht, unlimited e-bike availability, as well as some pleasant surprises along the way.



Itinerary

1st Day Embarkation Bodrum/Yalı Çiftlik

Individual arrival to Bodrum/Yalı Çiftlik harbour. A collective transfer from Bodrum Airport to the harbour is available for an extra cost on request. The ship Boreas starts in Bodrum harbour and the ship Admiral in the little town Yalı Çiftlik, which belongs to the city district of Bodrum. Check-in on board is possible from 2:00 PM. Your tour guide will be happy to provide tips on how to spend the afternoon. Dinner on board and overnight stay in Bodrum/Yalı Çiftlik.

2nd Day Yalıçiftlik (round tour) – Kos(aprx. 23 mi./38 km)

After breakfast we start our first bike ride through the local pine forests to Camlik where we will have the chance to refresh ourselves with a short coffee break. We continue cycling through silver-green olive groves to the small village of Etrim. Ancestors of the Turkmen tribes continue to live semi-nomadic lives in the region. We can marvel at their fascinating hand crafts and during a lunch break at a local restaurant we can discover some local cuisine. After lunch we return to Yaliciftlik where we board the boat and cruise to the island of Kos. A wealth of cultural sights in Kos town provide an insight into the town's turbulent historical past including the Roman Forum, the Crusader fortress, and the mosques from the time when Kos was part of the Ottoman Empire. The evening can be spent in one of the numerous bars or cafes in the town.

3rd Day Kos Island/Kos Town - Nissyros Island(aprx. 19 mi./30 km)

Today we bike in the direction of the world-famous archaeological excavation site of the Asclepion in Kos, the former home of Hippocrates, the father of modern medicine. From here we cycle along the coast back towards the town of Kos, where we board the boat and cruise to the volcanic island of Nissyros.

4th Day Nissyros Island – Tilos Island(aprx. 19 – 25 mi./30 - 40 km)

Today's cycle tour leads us first to Nikia - a mountain village built directly on the edge of the volcanic crater at 1,400 ft./430 m above sea level. From here we can enjoy a spectacular view into the crater of the volcano. The volcano, white houses, and numerous pebble mosaics are a truly special highlight of this tour. From here we cycle on along the crater with its steaming sulphur springs before heading back to the small port town of Mandraki where our boat is already waiting to take us to Tilos Island, inhabited since ancient times.

5th Day Tilos Island - Chalki island(aprx. 14 mi./22 km)

Our morning bike ride takes us from Livadia to Megalochorio. Here, those interested have time to visit the pygmy elephant museum, before returning to the boat. A tasty lunch awaits us on board followed by a relaxing cruise from Tilos to the island of Chalki. The picturesque island capital offers a first impression of the classic architecture style which we will see on Symi.

6th Day Chalki Island – Symi Island(aprx. 16 mi./25 km)

In the morning we sail to Panormitis Bay, which lies just off the island of Symi, to visit the local monastery. Afterwards, we head off for the other side of the island. Cycling up several switchbacks, we slowly conquer the hill, allowing ourselves enough time to enjoy the picturesque views on the way up. Our destination is the island's capital, Symi, with its classical cityscape and harbour. In the evening, we can head to the upper part of Symi town. From the top we have a

breath-taking view over the harbour and the coastline of the bay. An evening visit to a remote tavern allowa us to enjoy the evening away from the hustle and bustle of city life.

7th Day Datça – Knidos - Bodrum/Yalıçiftlik(aprx. 26 mi./41 km)

In the morning, we make our way from Symi to the neighbouring Datça Peninsula, back in Turkey. Today's bike tour takes us from the Datça district along the peninsula to the historical ruins of Knidos (4th century BC) with its wonderfully preserved amphitheatre. After a visit to the impressive archaeological site, you will cross over to Yalıçiftlik. We say farewell to guests, guides, and crew with a festive evening on board.

8th Day Disembarkation

Disembarkation after breakfast. Collective transfers to Bodrum Airport. If you wish to fly home from the Island of Kos, your ferry will depart at 9:30 am. Please ensure that your flight departure from Kos is no earlier than 1 pm.

Arrival

Embarkation Bodrum / Yalı Çiftlik

This tour begins and ends in Bodrum or Yalı Çiftlik. The ship Boreas starts in Bodrum harbour and the ship Admiral in the little town Yalı Çiftlik, which belongs to the city district of Bodrum.

Both ports of embarkation are most easily reached by flying to Bodrum Airport (BJV).

To reach your ship comfortably and without a long search, we recommend booking a transfer with us in advance. We will be happy to provide you with the relevant prices upon request.

Berth Boreas (Bodrum Harbour)

Should you wish to make your own way to the boat, you will find the <u>Boreas</u> in the big yacht harbour (when looking out to sea, on the right-hand side of the fortress of St. Peter). Most commonly it will be moored next to the Datca Ferry dock. The specific mooring of the ships will only be decided the evening before the trip.

You can check in on board from 2:00 PM on the day of embarkation.

Berth Admiral (Yalı Çiftlik)

Embarkation on the Admiral takes place in Yalı Çiftlik, a small vilage just under 14 km away from Bodrum town. As the village only has one pier, you can't miss the ship. The small jetty is located directly at the Belediyesi YALI Fish Restaurant (on the right side of the beach as seen from the shore). As soon as you stand on the beach of Yali Ciftlik you will already see the boat.

You can check in on board from 2:00 PM on the day of embarkation.

Arrival by plane

A flight is the fastest, easiest, and most economical way to get to Turkey.

The closest airport is Bodrum (BJV). Most flights go to Izmir (ADB), which is situated about three hours from Bodrum. During the high season it is also possible to fly directly to Bodrum Airport.

When you book your flight, we ask you to choose a return flight with a departure

time during noon or the afternoon hours so that we can facilitate a stress free journey home for you.

You can prebook an exclusive airport transfer from Bodrum Airport to Bodrum Harbour (day of embarkation / disembarkation only).
